

## EXCLUDED AREAS MEMORANDUM

At adventure For Hire, we want to ensure the safety of our customers whilst giving you an affordable and memorable adventurous holiday. This memorandum has been developed with our customers in mind, as outback Australia can be a harsh unforgiving place. Please ensure these exclusions are followed carefully as your standard cover options are built on this information, **and failure to comply with these directions are likely to result in your standard cover being void.**

1. Adventure for Hire 4WD's vehicles can be driven on recognised unsealed tracks.
2. Adventure for Hire 4WD's must not be driven at night or at dusk or dawn due to the high movement of animals during these times.
3. Adventure for Hire 4WD's are only permitted to gazetted roads.
4. Adventure for Hire 4WD's must not be driven on any roads that have been closed by any federal, state or local authority.
5. Adventure for Hire 4WD's vehicles may only travel to the following areas with the written approval of Adventure for Hire.
  - a. Simpson Desert
  - b. Cape York
  - c. Telegraph Track
  - d. MT Webb Wakooka Road
  - e. Old Gunbarrel highway
  - f. The Bungles Bungles
  - g. Canning Stock Route
  - h. Burke Development road -North of Karumba
  - i. Burke Development road -West of Chillagoe
  - j. Gibb River road
  - k. Boggy Hole
  - l. Old South Road from Maryvale to Finke
  - m. Lost city in Litchfield National Park
  - n. Strzelecki Track
  - o. Creb Track
6. Adventure for Hire 4WD's are not permitted to drive on any beach or be in any contact with salt water. Driving on any beach or coming in contact with salt water will void all standard cover. Any damage that occurs during or after the customer is 100% liable for all repairs/recovery costs.
7. Adventure for Hire 4WD's vehicles are not permitted to cross any water higher than 450mm.
